
**On March 13, 2020 all HPISD schools were closed due to the Public Health Care Declarations caused by the COVID-19 Pandemic.**

A call for service is generated anytime an officer responds to a dispatched event or self-initiates an event.






## NIBRS Group A Crimes Reported

## Municipal Warrant Clearance/Contact Activity



# Beat Staffing Average


Beat Staffing is the average daily number of officers assigned to beat areas on a per shift basis.

On 03-13-2020 a Public Health Emergency Declaration was issued by Dallas County.

This was followed by a City of UP declaration the same day. On 3-13-2020 the HPISD cancelled in-person classroom instruction and extracurricular activity and have since cancelled all school activity for the remainder of the 2019-2020 school year. As a result Officers assigned to HPISD campuses (SRO & DARE) were re-assigned to Patrol Operations to supplement shift staffing.

HPISD began in-person classroom instruction on 9-8-2020. As a result Officers assigned to HPISD returned to their SRO and DARE assignments
