# Doggie Splash Day

## Rules & Regulations

These rules are for the safety and protection of everyone who participates in the event, people and animals!

Please make sure you have read them prior to arriving at the event.

- 1) NO PUBLIC SWIMMING.
- 2) NO DOGS WILL BE ADMITTED WITHOUT PROOF OF VACCINATIONS.
- 3) Owners are legally responsible for their dogs and any injuries or damages caused by them.
- 4) Dogs whose behavior is unruly or might prove hazardous to other participants, dogs, or spectators may be requested to leave.
- 5) Dog waste must be cleaned up by owners and disposed of properly.
- 6) All dogs must be on a leash while not in the pool. A tagged collar must be on dogs at ALL times.
- 7) No electric, pinch, spike, and/or choke collars allowed.
- 8) Dog owners must closely supervise their dog(s) at all times, and may not leave their dog unattended while leaving the pool premises.
- 9) Dogs must be under control at all times.
- 10) Each handler/owner is limited to no more than two (2) dogs.
- 11) While swimming in the pool, only one human friend is allowed to accompany the dog.
- 12) Children under seven (7) years of age must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- 13) The following are not allowed in the pool area:
  - Female dogs in heat
  - Aggressive dogs
  - Puppies under six (6) months of age
  - Dogs that are not in good health
  - Animals other than dogs
  - Alcoholic beverages, food, glass containers
  - NO rawhides, bones or dog treats
  - Bicycles, skateboards, roller-skates/blades, or any motorized devices (except wheelchairs)
  - Small toys that could be a choking hazard to dogs
