





A call for service is generated anytime an officer responds to a dispatched event or self-initiates an event.





Travel time is calculated from the time the first officer is dispatched to a call for service until the first officer arrives on scene.







Red Light Cameras

NOTE: HB 1631, which prohibits the use of red light cameras, was signed into law by Governor Abbott on 6-2-2019 and was effective immediately. As a result processing of red light camera violations was ceased on that date. No violation data was received after 5-27-2019.

Red Light Cameras are placed at 4 locations in the city - Lovers at Dickens, Lovers at Preston, Daniel at Hillcrest Northbound, and Daniel at Hillcrest Southbound. A video of each violation is reviewed prior to confirming the violation is ready for prosecution.




